Sample Written Homework

Cindy Moss

Finance #1, 3,

1. A friend lends you \$200 for a week, which you agree to repay with 5% interest. How much will you have to repay?

$200(1 + 0.05) = \boxed{\$210}$

2. A T-bill is a type of bond that is sold at a discount over the face value. What annual interest rate have you earned?

$l = 200$
 $t = 13/52$

Upper right hand corner

First and last name

Top line (middle)

Chapter number and problem numbers worked on that page

Body of paper

Problem number clearly labeled; information for problem written out neatly. You do not need to include the question prompt.

Underneath problem statement

All steps shown; always include appropriate diagrams
